- Reporting - Report is Due: It is mandatory that you complete the Gaming Event Revenue Report within 90 days after your event has occurred and your license period expires. - This licence has been issued with the understanding that your organization will comply with Section 9.2 of the Standard Procedures for Ticket Raffles, Restrictions for Minors (under the age of 19). If your organization has a Class B gaming event licence, it may not sell tickets to a minor unless the minor is: 13 years of age or older; or accompanied by an adult who is apparently the minor's parent or guardian and who consents to the sale. A minor may not sell tickets for a Class B licensed gaming event unless the ticket value is not more than \$5 and the minor is doing so as a volunteer.
- When discounted tickets are sold (e.g. \$1 each and / or 3 for \$2 or 10 for \$5) to ensure financial accountability, these tickets must be either a different ticket colour for each price category or a separate series of sequential numbers for each price category. Discounted tickets cannot be split and sold separately. Single tickets cannot be bundled and sold as discounted groups. Sale of tickets by "arm's length" is not permitted. Standard Procedures for Ticket Raffles, section 9 indicates: "For raffles using bearer tickets, all tickets must be sold for the price approved by the gaming event licence."
- For travel prizes and cruises: no taxes or additional fees (i.e. airport improvement fees, port fees) can be charged to the winner. Prizes of travel must be inclusive of these additional charges.
